



President's Message

Blue Mountain community College has made a positive impact on our community for more than 50 years.

Nearly every day someone shares their personal story of success with me. Individuals who came to BMCC for their educational needs now live and work in our community. They are among the thousands of people who have turned to BMCC for the education and training to accomplish career, professional, and personal goals. Throughout the years, instruction and programs at BMCC have changed to meet the demands of the workforce, and the campus has grown to serve more students.

This past year BMCC asked citizens across the college district to weigh in on what they value about the college. We heard from students, community members, business owners, and staff about what their priorities are for BMCC: they want current and relevant workforce training programs for jobs in our community; they want a safe place to learn; and they want expanded facilities, with up-to-date equipment.

In response to what we heard from the community, the BMCC Board of Education has taken steps to prepare for a ballot measure for the May 19, 2015 election. If approved by voters, this bond would cost taxpayers approximately 25 cents per \$1,000 of assessed property value. That is approximately \$36.25 per year for the median-valued home in Umatilla County and \$28 per year for the median-valued home in Morrow County. The goals of the proposed bond are in keeping with what we heard over the past year from our community -- maintain an affordable education, provide a safe and secure learning environment, and modernize facilities and equipment for high-demand careers.

As President, my job is to protect the community's investment while positioning Blue Mountain to meet the needs of the next 50 years. The proposed ballot measure would support these goals.
